# Case counts as of July 18, 2020

- Number of cases of COVID-19 in Philadelphia: 28,196
- Number of new cases yesterday: 122
- Number of COVID-19 deaths in Philadelphia: 1,665
- Overall risk in Philadelphia: high risk of community transmission
- Green doesn't mean go back to normal

## Understanding COVID-19 safety

#### Your risk depends on:

- Number of people you are exposed to
- Number of people those people are exposed to
- Whether you wear a mask (correctly)
- Whether you stay 6+ feet apart
- Handwashing or using hand sanitizer
- Your age and health
  - Chronic diseases like diabetes increase risk

- Barriers
- Isolation and Quarantine
- Distance
- Reduce Crowds
- Handwashing
- Clean
- Communicate
