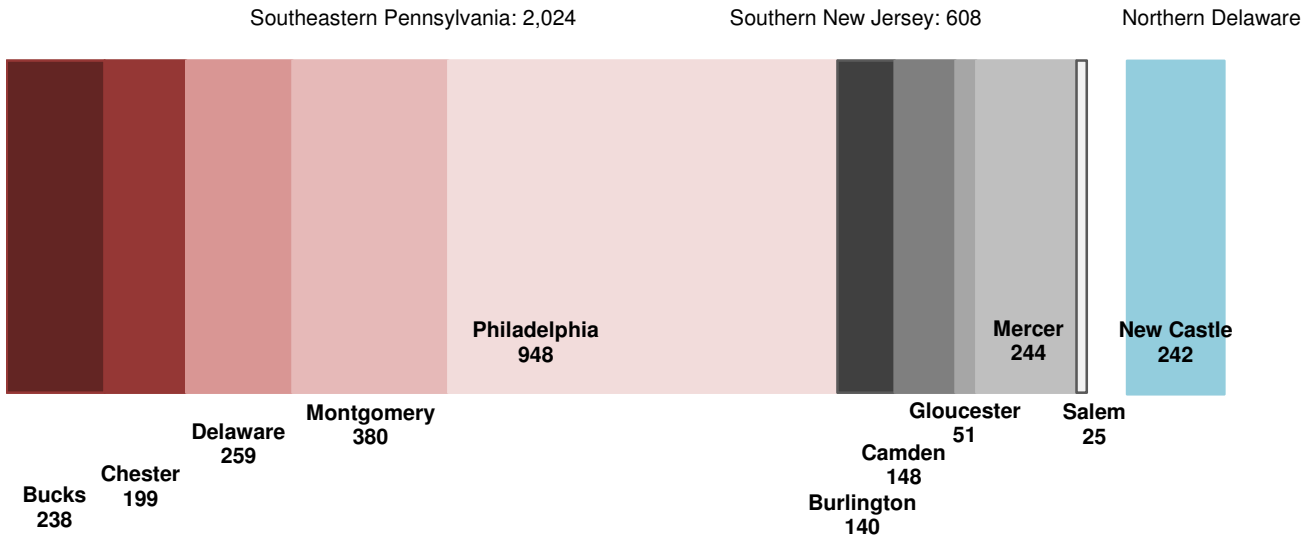


## How Many Arts and Cultural Organizations Are There in Greater Philadelphia?

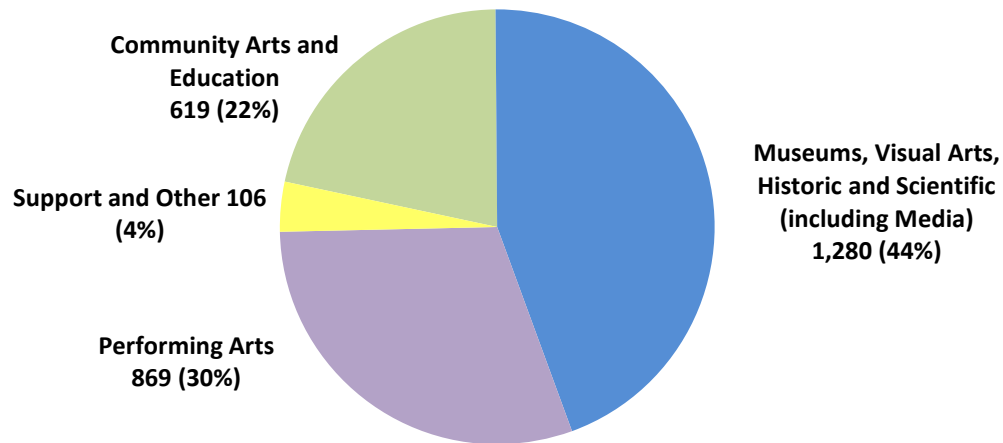

Every two years, the Greater Philadelphia Cultural Alliance conducts research to determine the overall number of arts and cultural organizations in the region. In doing so, we combine information from three large databases.

- As of 2010, there are over 2,000 organizations in Southeastern PA and over 2,800 organizations in the Greater Philadelphia region.
- A significant majority of all arts and cultural organizations (83%) have budgets under \$250,000 per year of annual expenses.
- Since 2008, the overall number of arts and cultural organizations in the region has increased by 5%, with the largest percentage increases in Burlington, Chester, Delaware, Gloucester, and Salem counties. Philadelphia had the highest number of new organizations (44).

▪ In the chart below, the high percentage changes in the number of Very Large, Large, and Medium organizations in some counties is due to a small number of organizations whose overall expenditures changed enough to move them from one category into another. In these categories, there were very few organizations, so these changes had a large effect on percentages.

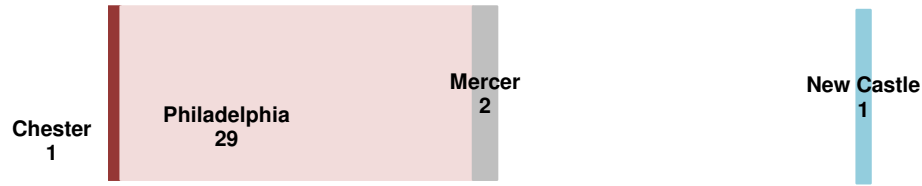

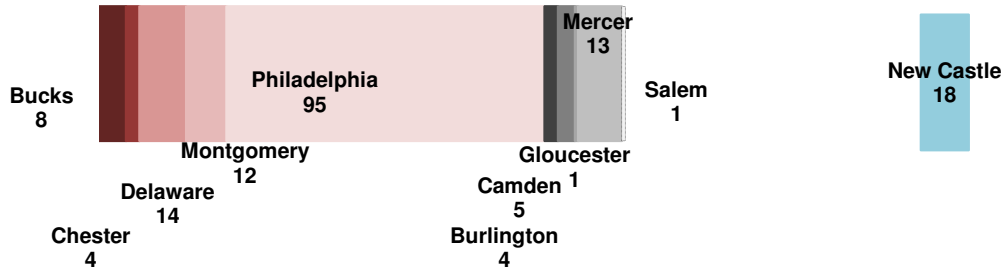

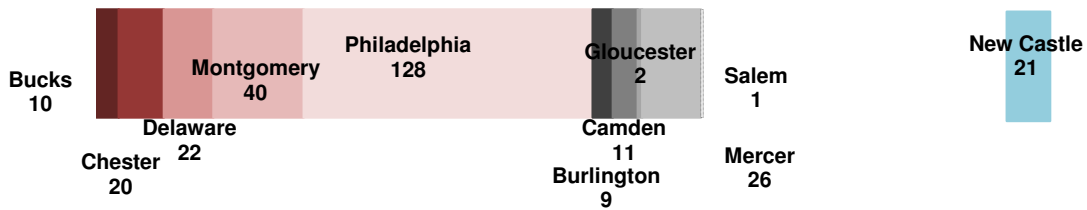
Very Large Organizations (annual expenses over \$10 Million)
